



1 Pre-study

- Identify a sector of the economy to study
- Determine the study's scope

2 Terms of reference

- Consult the Minister of Industry
- Publish a draft market study notice with proposed terms of reference
- Consult the public on the proposed terms of reference
- Get approval from Minister of Industry on final terms of reference

3 Publish the final terms of reference

- Launch the study

4 Research and analysis

- Gather internal and public information
- Call for submissions
- Contact interested individuals and groups for interviews and information requests
- Ask the court to order people with relevant information to share it with us where appropriate
- Analyse the information collected

5 Report

- Summarize the findings and any recommendations in a report
- Share a draft for feedback on factual accuracy and confidential information with people who received a court order for information

6 Publish the final report

- End the study

7 Post-study

- Promote our findings and explain what we learned
- Provide guidance on how to implement any recommendations
- Look for opportunities to build on our work
